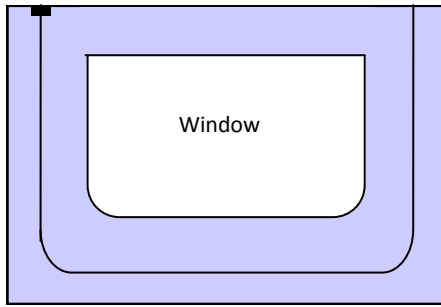

## Main Side and Opposite Side Configurations

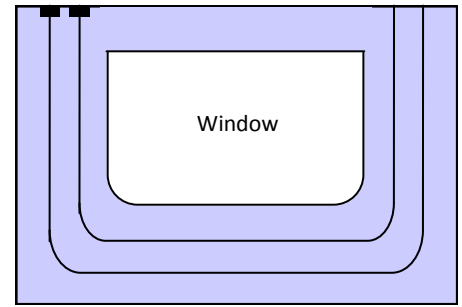
### Option 1

The zip is slightly below the top of the mattress. This is the **standard** opening for the **main** side and **optional** for the **opposite side**. (AI 28)



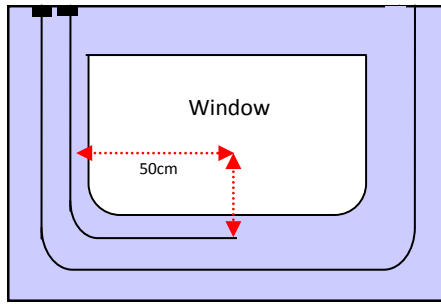
### Option 2

The main zip is slightly below the top of the mattress. The nursing access panel zip is 6" above the top of the mattress. (AI 32)



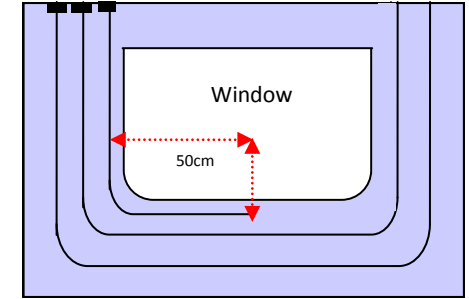
### Option 3

The main zip is slightly below the top of the mattress. The frequent access opening zip is 8" above the top of the mattress and opens 20" along the mattress length. (AI 96)



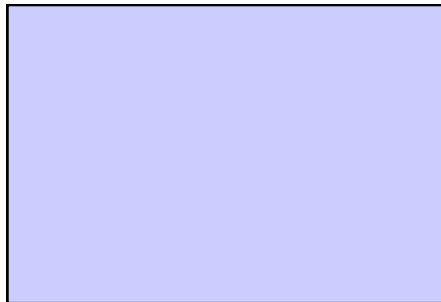
### Option 4

The main zip is slightly below the top of the mattress. The nursing access panel zip is 6" above the top of the mattress. The frequent access opening zip is 8" above the top of the mattress and opens 20" along the mattress length. (AI 32 + AI 96)



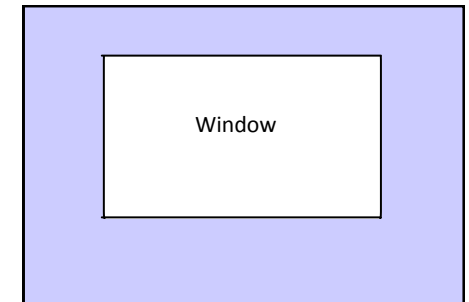
### Option 5

The standard configuration of the opposite side is a solid wall without window. Option 5 = solid panel for both opposite wall and Head/Foot selection.

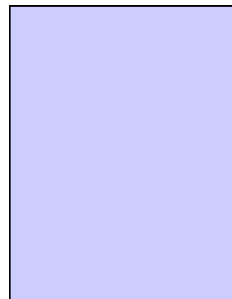
Non Opening viewing panel along opposite side. (AI 106 + AI 107)

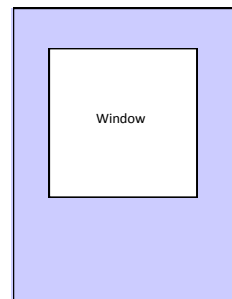
### Option 5

Optional solid wall in head or foot end for a lower stimulation environment. (No Charge)



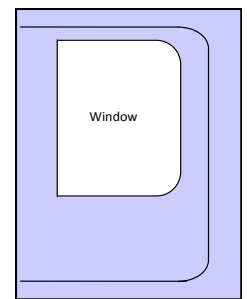
### Option 6

Standard configuration of Head and Foot end. Non opening viewing panel.

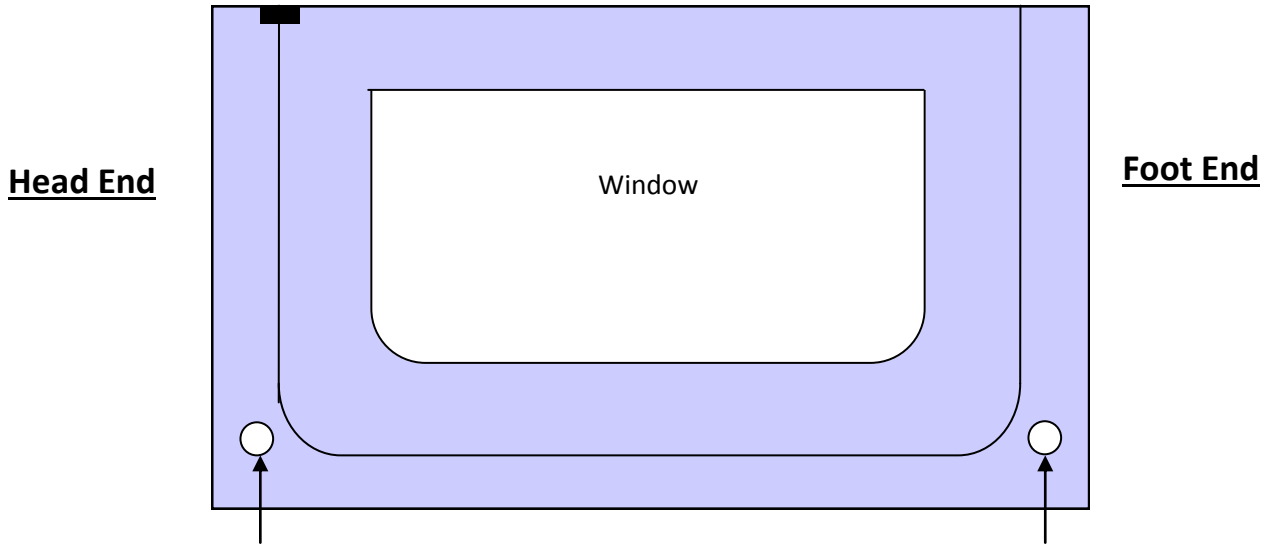


### Option 7

## Specifications

### Internal dimensions

- Internal dimensions: 79" x 35.5"
- Internal height from bed base to top of fabric: 55"
- Internal height from top of mattress to top of fabric: 49"
- Mattress thickness: 6"

### External dimensions

- Length x width: 88.5" x 46"

### Clearance required from hard surfaces

- Total sideways travel for Hi-Lo movement: 4.5" (In head/foot direction due to lift mech. design)
- From top of poles to room ceiling: 2"
- The Siesta front and rear opening panels need to be positioned at least 22" away from any wall or other hard surfaces
- The head and front panels need to be positioned at least 12" away from any wall or other hard surfaces
- Minimum floor to ceiling height required: 90"
